Shavuot marks the giving of the Torah on Mt. Sinai. The Ten Commandments are read in synagogues, just as they were in the desert on Mt. Sinai over 3,300 years ago.



ETHANIM

This was the seventh lunar month of the sacred calendar of the Israelites, but the first of the secular calendar. (1Ki 8:2) It corresponded to part of September and part of October. Following the Babylonian exile it was called Tishri, a name that does not appear in the Bible record but that is found in postexilic writings.

The Memorial of The Blowing of Trumpets begins Monday, September 26, 2022 at sundown and ends Tuesday, September 27, 2022 at sundown.



The Day of Atonement begins Wednesday, October 5, 2022 at sundown and ends Thursday, October 6, 2022 at sundown.

Yom Kippur

Begins sunset of Tuesday, October 4, 2022 Ends nightfall of Wednesday, October 5, 2022

- No work is permitted.
- Yizkor is recited on Yom Kippur, Wednesday, October 5

Yom Kippur is the holiest day of the year—the day on which we are closest to G-d and to the quintessence of our own souls. It is the Day of Atonement—"For on this day He will forgive you, to purify you, that you be cleansed from all your sins before G-d" (Leviticus 16:30).

The First Day of the Feast of Tabernacles begins Monday, October 10, 2022 at sundown and ends Tuesday, October 11, 2022 at sundown.

Sukkot

Begins sunset of **Sunday, October 9, 2022** Ends nightfall of **Sunday, October 16, 2022**

- No work permitted on October 10 11. Work is permitted on October 12 - 14 and October 16 with certain <u>restrictions</u>.
- Hoshanah Rabbah October 16, 2022

Dates listed are for outside Israel.

The seven days of Sukkot—celebrated by dwelling in the sukkah, taking the Four Kinds, and rejoicing—is the holiday when we expose ourselves to the elements in covered huts, commemorating G-d's sheltering our ancestors as they traveled from Egypt to the Promised Land. The Four Kinds express our unity and our belief in G-d's omnipresence. Coming after the solemn High Holidays, it is a time of joy and happiness

The Eighth Day Feast begins Monday, October 17, 2022 at sundown and ends Tuesday, October 18, 2022 at sundown.

Shemini Atzeret & Simchat Torah

Begins sunset of **Sunday, October 16, 2022** Ends nightfall of **Tuesday, October 18, 2022**

- 1 No work is permitted.
- Yizkor is recited on Shemini Atzeret, Monday, October 17

Dates listed are for outside Israel.

Following the seven joyous days of Sukkot, comes the happy holiday known as Shemini Atzeret/Simchat Torah.
